The Paris Peace Conference,

Keeping in mind, what enormous losses both to society and economy the World War brought us,

Fully alarmed by how unfair the situation during the war was and how many innocent people have died,

Deeply convinced that the two parties who are to blame for this conflict are Austria-Hungary and German Empire

Recognizing awful war crimes made by these countries, but also many others,

Emphasizing, that a situation like that can occur in the future,

Wishing, that such crimes never be committed again.

The Paris Peace Conference:

- 1) Reminds all nations that this war was unavoidable due to the rising hate between the countries and complicated alliances,
- 2) Recalls that Austria was reacting overly emotionally after the assassination of the Archduke,
- 3) Condemns the German Empire, which was attacking the civilians both on the ground and the sea as well as the neutral states of Belgium and Luxembourg and used chemical weapons,
- 4) Demands the main punishment of the German Empire and the Republic of Austria,
- 5) Expresses its hope that the debate will be just and fair,
- 6) Recognizes the Republic of Germany as responsible for the actions of the former German Empire,
- 7) certifies that some other countries, who took part in the war, are also partly to blame for the outbreak of war, while not blaming:
 - a) Belgium
 - b) Kingdom of Croats, Serbs and Slovenes
 - c) Kingdom of Hejaz
 - d) Dominion of Canada
 - e) Dominion of India
 - f) Poland
